

# Training Exercises

**73 training exercises since January 2004:**

- 28 action-based; 45 discussion-based

**Public Private partnerships**

- 2 staff dedicated to private sector and schools coordination

**NERT**

- 17,000 trained since Loma Prieta
- Citywide NERT drill on October 18th



- More than 177,000 participants citywide
- First annual City Wide Earthquake Drill occurred on October 21st
- City Departments, Businesses, Schools and Non-Profits all stopped and practiced what they'd do after an earthquake
- San Francisco Unified School District exercised opening their Operations Center for the first time in 10 years

## **Silver Sentinel**

- **Annual regional exercise conducted on October 23rd**
- **All 10 Bay Area counties and our community partners practiced coordinating response to a major Hayward Fault earthquake.**
- **Simulated supply and resource shortages, infrastructure failures**
- **Simulations inform plans to be used during real events**
- **International, federal and local observers**
